KADOGAWA'S history Exploration

1 **SANGASE Shrine**
This shrine is believed to be built in 1488.

2 **Wooden image of Saint NICHIREN**
According to the documents found inside of this statue, it is the oldest statue in Japan.

3 **Enshrinement hall of Buddha and stone monuments**
When you go to SANGASE Community Center, you will find enshrinement hall of a Buddha and stone monuments. Apparently, there was a shrine at the site.

4 **OKOSHIN SAN**
In order to protect the village from bad things, these stone statues were built at the entrance to the village. There are a lot of them in the town.

5 **KADOGAWA castle**
There are 3 KURUWA, the walls of Japanese castle and regions bounded by the arrangement of these walls. And there, you will be able to see the remains of the earthwork fortification.

6 **EIGAN Temple**
This temple is dedicated to YAKUSHI NYORAI and the 12 heavenly generals, Saint KOBO.

7 **IORIGAWA KOYASU KANNON**
The statue of a bodhisattva in IORIGAWA was believed to be a gift from TOKUGAWA IYASU who cared about his daughter who got married. People come to pray for smooth child rearing.

8 **OMIKURA SAN**
For the villagers who suffered from crop failures, a small shrine was built to pray for a bountiful harvest and for maritime safety.

9 **MISAKI GONGEN**
Right under THOMI Mountain, there is a shrine in a cave by the ocean. People come to pray for a big catch of fish.
