How to Separate and Dispose of Recyclable Resources and Garbage

Burnable garbage

<p>Kitchen Scraps *Please drain of water completely</p>	<p>Paper Scraps</p>	<p>Clothes</p>	<p>Rubber and Leather Items</p> <p>*Please remove the metal fittings</p>	<p>Tree Branches, Grass and Flowers</p> <p>*Within 50 cm</p>	<p>CD or Videotapes</p>
<p>Cooking Oil</p> <p>*Please absorb used cooking oil in paper or cloth, or use a solidifying agent before disposal</p>			<p>Disposable Diapers</p> <p>*Please remove waste from diapers.</p>	<p>Plastic Items</p> <p>*Other than recyclable garbage</p>	

Non-burnable garbage

<p>Can *NOT printed "Recycle mark" for cans</p>	<p>Electric Appliances</p> <p>*Microwave oven, rice cooker, vacuum cleaner, etc.</p>	<p>Harmful garbage</p> <p>*Dry-Cell Battery thermometer, lighter *Be sure to empty the lighter.</p>
<p>Glass Items/Ceramics</p>	<p>Metal Items</p>	<p>Spray cans and gas cylinders</p> <p>*Please remove all contents before disposing</p>

Recyclable garbage

<p>Bottles and Cans (Steel and aluminum) *Remove the caps</p> <p>Plastic caps and labels are Plastic containers. Metal caps are Non-burnable garbage. (Please wash well with water)</p>	<p>Old Paper (Newspapers, magazines, cardboard and milk cartons)</p> <p>*Cannot be collected on rainy days *Bundle items according to type.</p>
<p>Magazines/Books</p> <p>Tie those of the same size with string</p>	<p>Milk cartons</p> <p>Open, wash, dry, and tie them with string.</p>

Plastic containers

If it has this mark, it is eligible (Please wash cleanly) *It becomes Burnable garbage if dirt cannot be removed. *Please do not bring it to the clean center directly.

PET bottles

Plastic PET Bottles *This includes bottles with the PET mark used for beverages, sake, "mirin" cooking wine or soy sauce.
*Remove caps and labels.
*Rinse the inside.
